CAT was formed at the end of 2007 and began signing up members and hosting tournaments in 2008. The CAT founders had hoped to get 50 members the first year and field at least 10 teams at a few area tournaments. At the end of 2008, CAT's membership stood at 188 members and a total of 123 different anglers competed in at least one tournament. A total of 225 teams fished in 10 separate tournaments last year, weighing in a total of 901.28 POUNDS OF CRAPPIE!

CAT's rapid growth continued and even accelerated in 2009. Currently, we have nearly 260 members and we have had 40 or more teams fish each of tournaments so far this year. Last month, we had 51 teams compete at our tournament at Ray

Roberts!

The "crown jewel" in this year's tournament schedule will be the CAT Texas State Championship, held at Richland Chambers Reservoir on October 16th and 17th. This two day tournament will be the first time in Texas an angler will be able to compete in a state-wide tournament with the opportunity to earn the title "State Champion". The excitement surrounding this tournament will only continue to grow, as this promises to be the biggest crappie fishing event ever held in the state of Texas!
