







Drive-Through Weigh-In Plan

1. There will only be <u>one entrance</u> to the weigh-in line, on Highway 69. Look for the signs and Traffic Control Volunteers that will show you where to turn.

2. You will be directed through the weigh-in line by a series of Traffic Control Volunteers. You must follow the instructions of the Traffic Control Volunteers exactly.

3. <u>Even if you do not have a fish to weigh-in</u>, you should still follow this process and get your weigh-in card and a "Golden Ticket" for a chance at winning \$1,000.

4. After you receive your weigh-in card and "Golden Ticket", you will continue through the weigh-in line and will pass by booths set up by our Crappiefest Sponsors. Please take a minute to visit with our sponsors and thank them for their support.

5. Before you get to the weigh-in stage, there will be a display that will show the weight of the current "Big-Crappie" and the weight of the crappie currently in 20th place (Crappiefest pays cash for the top 20 crappie). This way, you can decide which crappie (if you are lucky enough to have more than one to chose from (2)) you want to present at the weigh-in. Remember, Crappiefest pays cash for each crappie weighing exactly 1.00, 1.25, 1.50, 1.75 and 2.00.

6. Before you get to the weigh-in stage, weigh-in volunteers will collect your weigh-in cards and your "Golden Ticket". Be sure and keep your half of the "Golden Ticket" so you can claim your \$1,000 prize if you win. You <u>do not</u> have to be present to win. Once you weigh your fish (or if you do not have a fish to weigh), you may leave if you wish. If weather and Covid-19 permit, we would appreciate it if you stayed for the excitement of the weigh-in, but you will receive any cash prize you qualify for even if you are not present to accept it. We want every participating adult angler, regardless of age or health conditions, to be able to enjoy Crappiefest and have an equal chance at winning a cash prize.

7. Once you get to the weigh-in stage, a weigh-in volunteer will hold out a net and you simply drop your crappie into the net. Your crappie will be weighed and either given back to you or, if you choose, placed in our live-release tank by the stage.

8. If you do not have a crappie to weigh, you can simply drive past the weigh-in stage.

9. Once you are finished with the weigh-in process, you may either leave or park in one of our designated parking areas and watch the remainder of the weigh-in (weather and Covid-19 permitting). DO NOT, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, PARK ANYWHERE EXCEPT THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS. Traffic Control Volunteers will be available to show you how to get to the designated parking areas.
