

Crappie Anglers of Texas Scholarship Program

The Crappie Anglers of Texas Scholarship Program (CATSP) seeks to identify high school seniors and college students who will make significant contributions to society. Applicants must exhibit strong academic and leadership skills and must participate in community service activities. The applicant must be a US citizen or hold a permanent resident card.

Eligible Applicants

- Must be a current member, child of a member, or grandchild of a current member in good standing with the Crappie Anglers of Texas
- Must be at least 17 years of age and be a high school senior in good standing or must be enrolled in an accredited college, university, or vocational school.
- Must have applied, be accepted to, and/or be registered to attend an accredited college, university, or vocational school.
- Must submit an official application form no later than May 1 2022.
- Must submit with application a written essay of no less than 500 words based on fishing, fishing habitat, fish conservation, water conservation, or wildlife conservation.
- Must have completed no less than 20 hours of voluntary community service no later than May 1, 2022, and must include proof of community service with contact information.
- Must not be a member of, or related to a member of, the CATSP Selection Committee.

CATSP Selection Committee

- The CATSP Selection Committee will be comprised of the Scholarship Fund Director and at least two other Crappie Anglers of Texas members in good standing selected by the Crappie Anglers of Texas Board of Directors.
- The CATSP Selection Committee will be responsible for reviewing applications, reading essays, and selecting a winner or winners of the scholarship no later than May 31, 2022.
- All questions regarding eligibility of applicants and sufficiency of the applications will be made by the CATSP Selection Committee.
